The cleanup event will consist of a cleanup and landscaping, putting up vinyl siding and shutters, deck painting, sheds need roof sheathing and shingles, interior caulking, painting and final touch up work, light construction and finish trim work, and power wash siding. We are encouraging anyone to bring simple hand tools; rakes, shovels, weed trimmers, and hammers. We have some power and carpentry tools, however anyone interested in carpentry should bring the tools they need.
